



Call for papers

As part of the publication of the first issue which will appear in December 2021, “Didactics” an international, biannual and peer-reviewed scientific journal, edited by the National Institute for Research in Education is launching a call for papers. The journal is specialized in the field of didactic of all disciplines and it is open to all scientific contributions.

The editorial line is based on an evaluation, by an international reading committee, publishing original research articles in the field of didactics in several languages (Arabic, French, and English).

The journal of didactic treat the issues related to the teaching / learning of the Arabic language, the didactics of foreign languages, the didactics of scientific subjects (mathematics, natural sciences, and physics, etc.), the didactics of the history of science, analysis of classroom practices, educational assessment and the integration of Information and Communication Technologies in Education (ICT).

The aim of the didactic Journal is to promote research work intended for a specialized audience (researchers and teacher-researchers). It is also addressed to national education executives (inspectors, didacticians) in order to support them in their professional activities; in particular to promote a quality school. It also offers to doctoral students and young researchers the opportunity to publish their research work.

The journal is distributed in Open Access, specifies and declares copyright, and ensures compliance with the code of ethics and professional conduct.

The editorial board comprises a publication director, editors-in-chief, co-editor in-chief, editorial secretariat, a scientific committee, a reading committee and three linguistic correctors.

The didactic Journal aims to:

- Mutualize knowledge in didactics between researchers and actors in the field of education;

- Promote and disseminate scientific research production in didactics;
- Contribute to the development of new approaches of teaching / learning disciplines;
- Offer a space for scientific debate on the teaching of disciplines.

The journal of Didactic also aims to become an information tool and a source of reference for practitioners in the field of education.

Axes :

- The didactics of the Arabic language and foreign languages;
- The didactics of scientific disciplines and social sciences;
- The didactics of the history of science.
- Classroom teaching / learning practices;
- Information and communication technologies for the benefit of education.
- Evaluation in education

Publication Requirements in the Journal:

Articles addressed to didactic must be submitted under the following requirements:

- Research articles should be in line with the field of didactics. Authors should ensure that they have submitted an original unpublished article, in whole or in part, in another journal or conference or other publication media.
- The research article should be written in one of the following languages: Arabic, English, and French. It should also include an abstract of no more than 10 lines (200 words). It is also necessary to translate the summary into English if the article is written in Arabic. If the article is written in a foreign language, the abstract should be translated into Arabic (200 words maximum).
- The length of the article should be 12 to 20 pages maximum.
- The body of the text should be written in Sakkal Majalla, size: 16 for the Arabic language and in Times New Roman, size: 14 for foreign languages.
- In order to unify the articles according to a single methodological model, it is necessary to respect the template of the journal.
- Bibliographic references should be written based on the international standard ISO 690-2010.

- Submitted articles cannot be removed once viewed by the editor in chief. They cannot be reviewed in another journal.
- The author's scientific biography should be attached to the article in one of the following languages: Arabic, English or French.
- All ideas published in the journal reflect the opinions of their authors and not of the journal. The order of published research articles is subject to technical requirements.
- The journal reserves the right not to publish any research article without giving reasons. Its decisions are considered final.
