Publication Requirements in the Journal

Articles addressed to didactic must be submitted under the following requirements:

1. Research articles should be in line with the field of didactics. Authors should ensure that they have submitted an original unpublished article, in whole or in part, in another journal or conference or other publication media.
2. The research article should be written in one of the following languages: Arabic, English, and French. It should also include an abstract of no more than 10 lines (200 words). It is also necessary to translate the summary into English if the article is written in Arabic. If the article is written in a foreign language, the abstract should be translated into Arabic (200 words maximum). Each abstract must be followed by five (05) keywords.
3. Content written in English (title, summary, keywords) should not be translated automatically.
4. The length of the article should be 12 to 20 pages maximum.
5. The body of the text should be written in Sakkal Majalla, size: 16 for the Arabic language and in Times New Roman, size: 12 for foreign languages.
6. In order to unify the articles according to a single methodological model, it is necessary to respect the template of the journal.
7. Bibliographic references should be written based on the international standard ISO 690-2010.
8. Submitted articles cannot be removed once viewed by the editor in chief. They cannot be reviewed in another journal.
9. The article is subject to a double anonymous expertise, it is then either accepted as it is, or refused, or accepted and being subject to major or minor corrections. The author will be informed of any decision.
10. All ideas published in the journal reflect the opinions of their authors and not of the journal. The order of published research articles is subject to technical requirements.
